Total Floor Polish Remover

PRODUCT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION:

ERAZER is a heavy duty floor stripper formulated for economy of use through high end use dilution rates to remove heavily burnished or high build-ups of metal cross linked sealer finishes with minimum labour.

ERAZER is safe for use on most resilient floors and quickly softens and emulsifies old worn and discoloured finishes for ease of removal.

ERAZER must NOT be used to remove sealer finishes from sealed timber floors as it may affect the timber seal, requiring sanding to rectify the floor.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS:

- For economic use through high end use dilution rates to remove heavily burnished or high build-up of metal cross linked sealer finishes.
- Minimum labour required.
- Safe for most resilient floors.
- Quickly softens and emulsifies old worn and discoloured finishes for ease of removal

USE:

ERAZER can be diluted up to 1 part to 10 parts with water for removing light build-ups, or up to 1 part per 6 parts water for heavier build-ups.

Apply **ERAZER** solutions liberally to the floor with a cotton mop ensuring the entire floor surface is thoroughly wet. Work in small controllable area sizes. Allow at least 5 minutes contact and then scrub with a slow speed rotary scrubber or automatic scrubber fitted with a black, brown or high productivity pad. In larger areas take care not to allow solution to dry off. After scrubbing, pick up slurry and rinse thoroughly with clean water to ensure all residues are removed.

Allow the floor to dry prior to proceeding with the restoration process and restrip any areas that may have been missed.

NOTE: During the emulsification process most floors become extremely slippery. Care should be taken when working on wet floors. Place Safety Signs and prevent public entry.

SAFETY:

First Aid

Eyes: If splashed in eyes, flush with water for 15min. Seek medical advice.

Skin: Wash affected area with soap and water.

Inhalation: If mists are inhaled, remove patient to fresh air. Seek medical advice.

Swallowed: Do NOT induce vomiting. Give milk or water to dilute. Seek medical advice.
